**Both workshops will start at noon and last for about two hours. I will be at the facility from about 10 AM to 3 PM on both days.** After I cover the material that needs to be presented, students may "hang around" and work on the simulator software that will be set up and running.

I will be presenting "LESSON SHEET 2" (orbital mechanics) and doing the Crew Cabin familiarity lesson in the simulator.

If you have a laptop computer, you can bring it to the workshop and load some of the software and training manuals if you do not have all the materials from the Lesson Sheets. I will also have new handouts for upcoming lessons.

If you have not started the training, feel free to attend the workshop to get started. The Space Shuttle simulator facility is located at the old Mountain Oaks School library.
