### **Foothill Rideshare – Helping to Share the Ride**

Foothill Rideshare is a free ridematching service available in the foothills areas of Calaveras, Tuolumne, and Amador Counties. In January 2006, Foothill Rideshare was established for the purpose of promoting rideshare efforts in this tri-county area. The Calaveras Council of Governments administers the rideshare program in partnership with the Amador County Transportation Commission, the Tuolumne County Transportation Council, and the San Joaquin Council of Governments.

The Foothill Rideshare program offers viable rideshare options to commuters, students, and anyone who needs to share a ride to, from, in, or around our counties. For families who drive 10 miles or more to take their students to school, sharing the ride with others can substantially reduce travel costs.
